## 96 Years and Counting.....



On this day, in 1927, Round Table was formed in Suckling House, Norwich England. Now in over 55 countries around the world it all started with this speech........

"The young business and professional men of this country must get together <u>round</u> the <u>table</u>, <u>adopt</u> methods that have proved so sound in the past, <u>adapt</u> them to the changing needs of the times and wherever possible, <u>improve</u> them"

These words were given in a speech by the then Prince of Wales at the British Industries Fair. Louis Marchesi had already had the idea of starting a club for young men and this speech spurred him on. On the 14th March 1927 Round Table was formed at Suckling House in Norwich taking the motto 'Adopt, Adapt, Improve' which we still use today.

The 100th anniversary of the founding is only four years away. How is your organisation planning to celebrate this major event?





### **Easter Trivia Facts**

Easter 2023 will be celebrated on the 9th April.





- Easter always occurs between March 22 and April 25.
- Easter is a "movable feast" one that is set according to the phases of the moon so the dates are different each year.
- It is believed by some that Easter was named after the Anglo-Saxon goddess, Eastre, whose symbols were the egg and the hare (rabbit).
- More than 90 million chocolate Easter bunnies are manufactured each year.
- The first Easter eggs were coloured red, in memory of the blood Jesus shed during his crucifixion.
- The largest chocolate Easter Egg was created in Tosca (Italy). It weighed 15,873 lbs., 4.48 oz., and had a circumference of 64 ft., 3.65 in. at its widest point.
- In the 13<sup>th</sup> century, the church prohibited the eating of eggs during Holy Week. Marking the eggs laid during the week began the custom of decorating eggs.
- In Britain, certain foods are associated with the celebration of Easter:
- Hot Cross Buns, a Good Friday treat, contain raisins or currants and then topped by a glazed icing cross.
- Roast lamb, the main dish at Jewish Passover, is the traditional meat for the main meal on Easter Day.
- Simnel, a fruit cake with marzipan (sugared almond paste) on top and 11 marzipan balls representing the 11 apostles (not Judas, who betrayed Christ), served at tea time.
- Easter biscuits or cakes, eaten on Easter Sunday, containing spices, currants, and grated lemon rind.
- In the United States, traditional Easter foods include ham, chicken, and lamb.
- It is believed that an Italian baker made the pretzel to look like arms crossed in prayer during the Passover season sometime between the 300s and the 600s.
- Americans consume over 16 million jellybeans on Easter, enough to circle the globe more than three times.
- In some European countries, other animals in Switzerland the cuckoo, in Westphalia the fox brought the Easter eggs.

Unfortunately, according to the Local authority Electricity Company office, the device cannot yet be put into operation, as the old cables and switch boxes are no longer suitable for it.

#### Action:

Get a local offer for new installation and collect donations or the request via Side by Side, who can help here with material and "hands on".

Jürgen Ahlert offered us 100 stacking chairs, which are needed in the "House of Hope".

#### Action:

Plan delivery with one of the next convoys. –Jürgen confirmed the need on 20.03. He takes care of it. Kirill told us that solar panels are urgently needed in Kherson. Quantities, address and name of the institution follow.

#### Action:

Possibly. Purchase via the network, or call via side-by-side.

Kirill mentioned that hearing aids are needed for 4 people.

#### Action:

Tommy Führer will contact Andreas Perscheid as soon as I have received the confirmed audiograms.

In the front area of the "House of Hope" a playground is required for the children is to be created (see picture). Preparations, such as clearing the areas, are in full swing.

#### Action:

The playing area must be fenced in. I requested an offer directly on site. For playground equipment such as slides, etc., a separate call could run via social networks. Has anybody any contacts for such equipment?

Bringing colour to the "House of Hope". As soon as the electrical work is completed, the holes in the walls should be filled and the interior recreated with paint.

#### Action:

Peter Krahl would provide a bus in July. Thus, a "hands on tour" to Ciobalaccia would be possible. "Side by Side" on the bus and do everything for 1 week on site. Paint and filler is cheaper to buy in Moldova.






