



Sharing your knowledge and experience on video is simple with StoryTagger

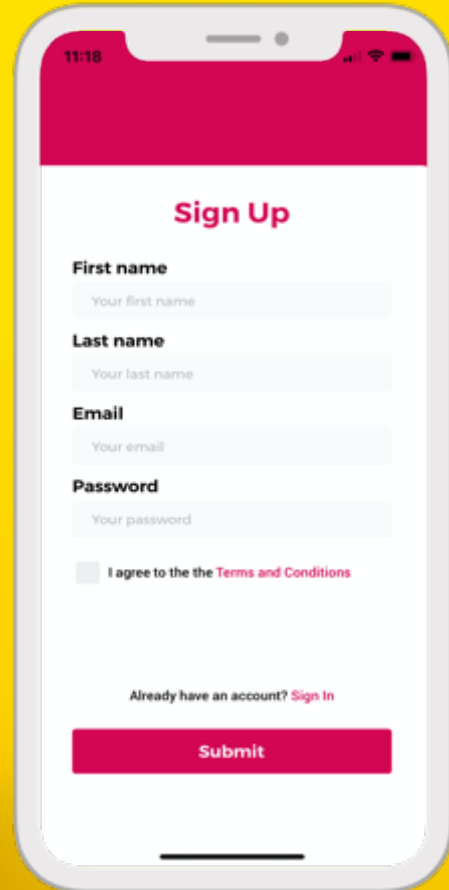
Have you been asked to record a video to share with your colleagues?

Don't worry. Even though most people aren't used to recording videos for work, the good news is StoryTagger makes the process simple, quick and secure. This short guide will show you what to do next.

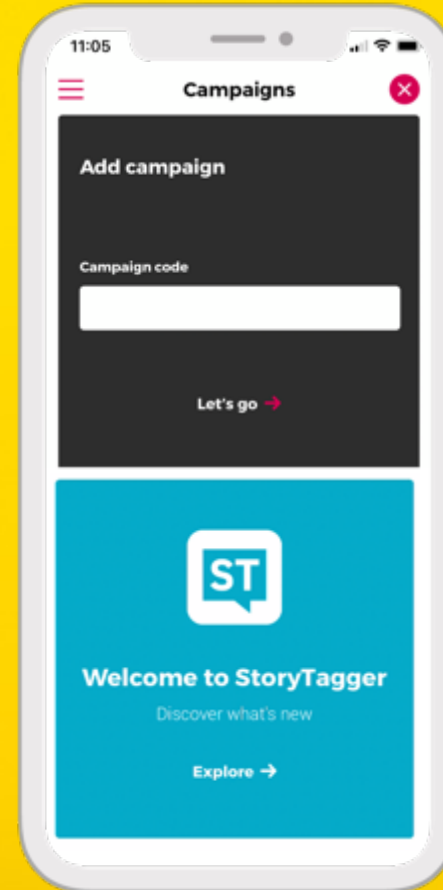
Download 'StoryTagger' from your mobile app store.



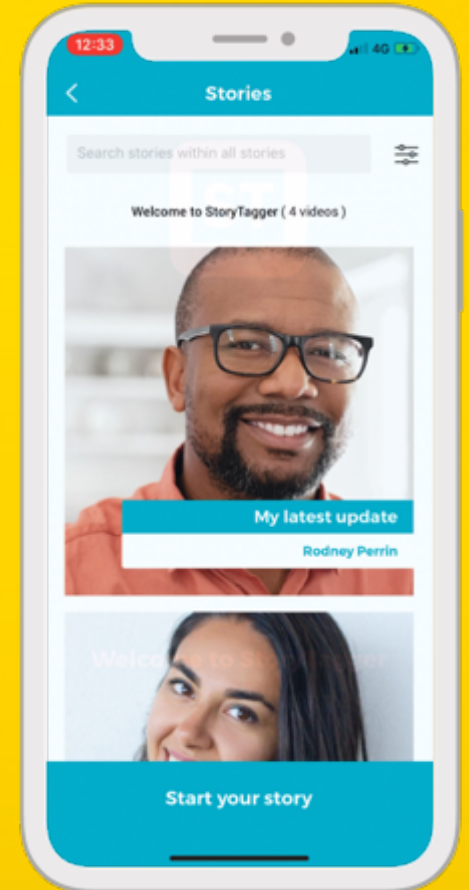
Step 1: Get started – it's a breeze



First, create an account by using the same email address as your invitation.

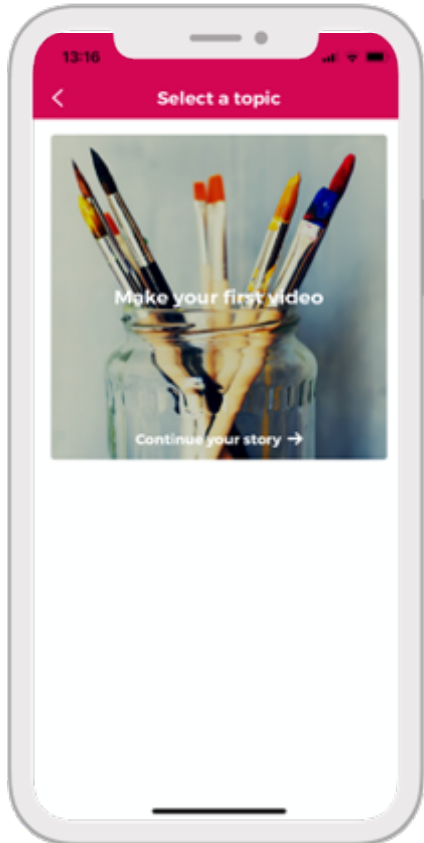


Or, if you received a Campaign code, add it here. You'll receive an email asking you to confirm your account.



Tap to explore 'Campaigns' available to you. Watch the welcome or any published 'Stories' for inspiration.

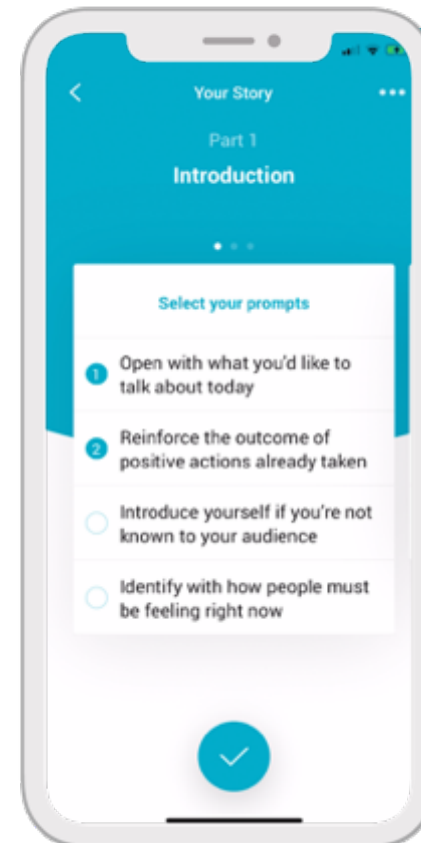
Step 2: Plan your story – what will you share?



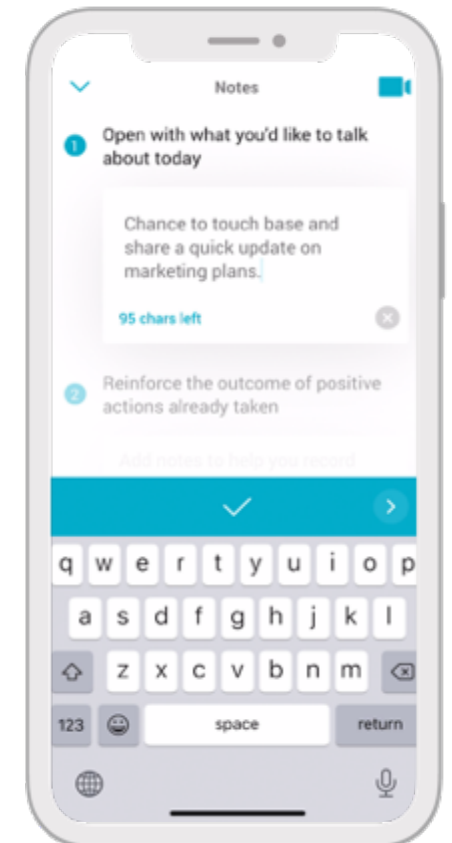
Select a topic and tap on 'Start your story'.



Before you start filming, preview the story structure and work out what you'd like to say. Keep an eye on how long you have for each Part e.g. Max 30s.



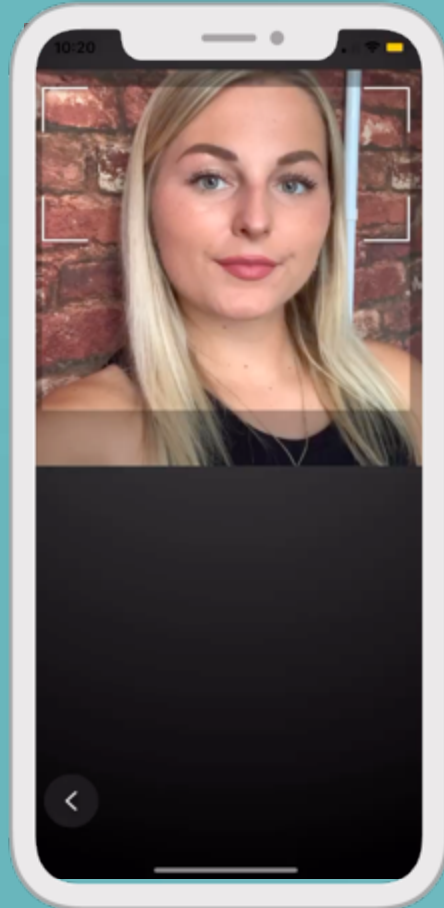
Use the prompts provided to start crafting your story.



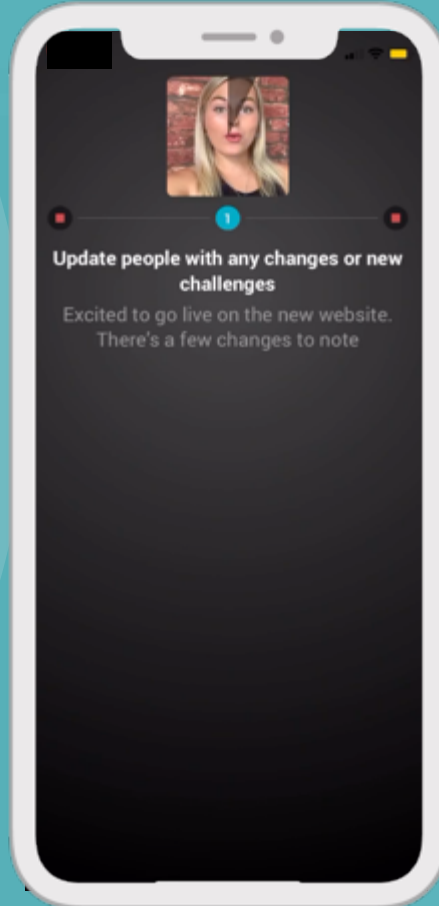
Add some notes to remind you of your key points when you're recording your video.



Step 3: Record your video, stress-free

Find a well-lit area where you feel comfortable. StoryTagger's smart recording mode will help you get your sound, lighting and framing just right.

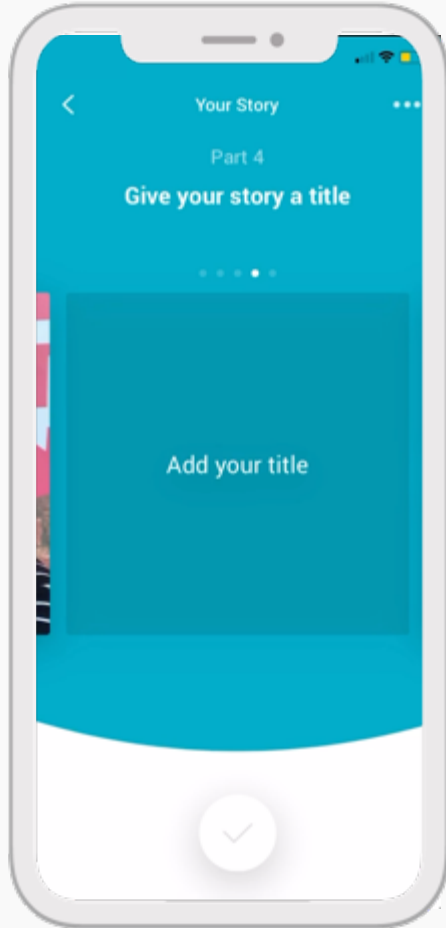
Keep your eyeline on the camera and swipe through your prompts and notes. Just tap the screen to pause or stop recording.



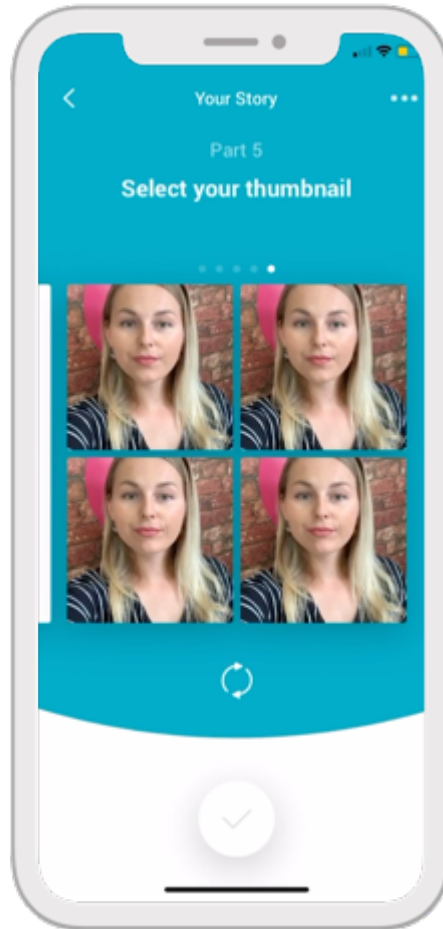
QUICK TIP

Preview each part and re-record as many times as you like. You can even record your intro at the end, so your video starts with an extra confident welcome!

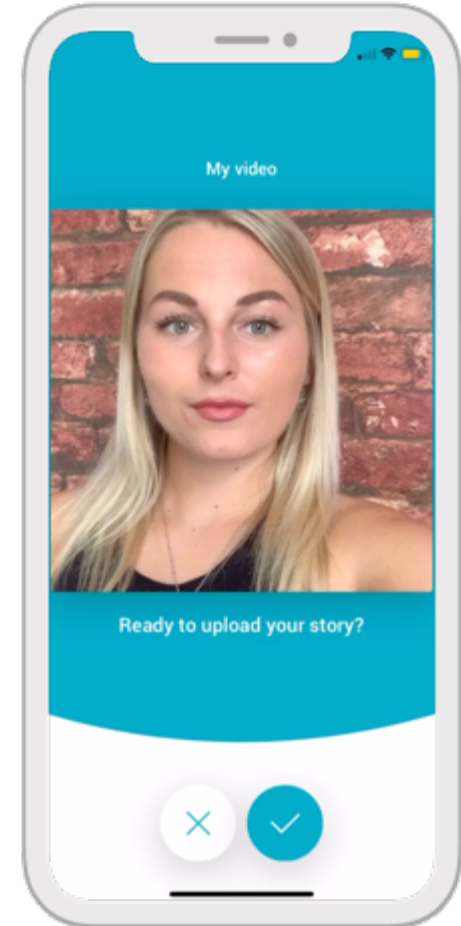
Step 4: Preview and upload



Give your story a descriptive title that lets viewers know what it's about.



Select a thumbnail, refreshing until you find one you like.



Upload your story to your curation team by tapping the tick.
