#### What is Find a Grant?

Find a Grant is a single place for individuals and organisations to find and apply to general government grants. It has been delivered by the Government Grants Management Function (GGMF), Cabinet Office, in partnership with DCMS, Defra, DIT and MoJ.

In April 2021, the GGMF secured funding from HMT's Shared Outcomes Fund to test a new online grants service for making it simpler, faster and fairer for any organisation or member of the public across the UK to find and apply for funding.

This service has been designed to:

- publicise grants in one place with equal and fair access for all;
- enable the finding of government grants by browsing, searching and filtering;
- offer applicants opt-in notifications for individual grants, customised saved searches or general service updates when new grants are added every week.

In January 2023, Ministers took the decision to mandate Find a Grant, so that all eligible general grants should be advertised on the service from April 2023.

This manual has been prepared for Grant Admins to support them in getting set up with access to Find a Grant.



#### Registration

Grant administrators will first need to register on the service, before contacting the Find a Grant team (<u>findagrant@cabinetoffice.gov.uk</u>) to be assigned the permissions required to create grant adverts.

#### Where do I register?

To get started, visit our user <u>registration page</u> and complete the following information to create an account:

#### **Request Grant Admin Access**

Once registered, email <u>findagrant@cabinetoffice.gov.uk</u> to request your account be given Grant Admin access.

The Find a Grant team will make this change to your account for you and send you a confirmation email once your account is ready. This can take up to 24 hours from your request.
