# National Immunisation Network 2024

**Immunisation is the single most effective way to help protect our population against infectious diseases. It is a right for every child, teenager, and adult in the UK, and we strive to ensure everyone eligible is up to date with their routine immunisation schedule in order to protect our population across the life course.**

The theme for this year's meeting is "**Protecting every generation**" focusing on new developments in the routine and selective programmes. The sessions including sessions from national and international experts, panel debate, opportunities for discussion and networking and will provide all those in the field with up-to-date information on new developments in the national programmes and on actions to support the recovery of uptake of the routine and selective immunisations.

Immunisation is a fast-moving area of expertise. Providing an annual 2-day conference allows us an opportunity to come together, face to face to support our training and development, to share experiences, find out about previously unpublished coverage and uptake data/perspectives and meet the national teams. The conference is a unique opportunity to bring together national teams, representatives of the regional teams, key stakeholders such as SAIS teams, practice staff and practitioners who can implement behavioural change and strategies to improve uptake, address health inequalities and support activities to maintain/increase immunisation rates in all settings.

The meeting will provide a valuable opportunity to hear the most recent information, learn about resources available to support the programmes and to share examples of good practice in operational delivery and response.
