

Weapons Foundation Course: Consists of 3 four week modules – Core Weapons, Flight Safety and Tactical Control. All of this course is conducted in the simulator environment at RAF Shawbury.

ASACS Ground School: Prepares students for the live element of training and for employment on their first tour as QRA Weapons Controllers, when working towards Combat Ready Status. This 4 week module includes an introduction to battlespace management, mission planning and electronic warfare.

Operational Conversion Unit: The main element of the Weapons Control Course. You will put into practice everything learnt to date in both simulated and live environments. By the end of the course you will be controlling up to 4 fast jets (2v2) in a live flying environment.

First Tour: Your first tour will last for approximately 3 years and will be at the Control and Reporting Centre at RAF Boulmer as a QRA Weapons Controller. During this time you will also be expected to gain Combat Ready Status. You will achieve this by taking part in a number of major air exercises controlling larger aircraft packages in combat-based scenarios
