Please note that you will only need to follow these instructions the first time that you log into your PCN EMIS account. Once the steps below have been successfully completed, they will not need to be worked through again.

- 1. Ensure that EMIS is not already open if it is, close it and remove your smartcard from the keyboard do not re-insert your smartcard until prompted to in **step 11** below
- 2. Open EMIS Web by double clicking on the EMIS Web icon on the desktop of your PC
- 3. When the login screen appears click on the 'Change organisation' button:

- 16. EMIS will display a message confirming that the smartcard role has been associated successfully. Click on the **OK** button.
- 17. EMIS will now close and then re-open (sometimes takes a while so you may have to wait a minute or so for this to happen)

Once EMIS has restarted the initial setup of your PCN EMIS account is complete. You can now close EMIS in the usual way and remove your smartcard from the keyboard.
