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Overview of courses available:

Our training is professionally approved by the Education Training Standards Committee of the National Youth Agency, who are the professional statutory regulatory body for youth work. It is also recognised by the Joint Negotiating Committee for youth work- setting the pay, terms and conditions for youth workers in England.

The Level 1: Award:
This comprises of 6 Mandatory Modules:
While the Level 1 Award is not a JNC recognised qualification, it does provide a comprehensive and knowledgeable foundation in Youth Work practice and principles, safeguarding and an introduction to the principles that underpin safe and effective youth work.

Level 2 – AWARD 4 Mandatory Modules.

The award can also form the basis from which to progress to the Level 2 – Certificate. Offering more flexibility to learners to progress.

Level 2 – CERTIFICATE – JNC (2)

8 Mandatory Learning Modules + 1 ADDITIONAL MODULE to be selected from a current range of 7 various options

This certificate is the minimum recognised qualification in Youth Work Practice required for those wanting to work as a JNC qualified Youth Support Worker assistant, and is recognised as the industry standard qualification for youth work at this level.

Level 3 – Certificate – JNC (3)

This comprises of 8 Mandatory Modules + 1 ADDITIONAL MODULE to be selected from a range of over 20 various options

This qualification is the minimum level for JNC Youth Support Workers, it may be used as an access route to study a BA (Hons) Higher Education Youth work Programme.

Level 3 – Diploma JNC (4)

This comprises the same 8 Mandatory Modules as the Level 3 Certificate, but this qualification requires an additional 13 credits from the group of options.

Offering over 20 additional learning modules, these aim to benefit the learner by offering both flexibility and diversity to their knowledge, ensuring inclusivity towards a wide range of youth work settings.
